Rt. Hon. Helen Elizabeth Clark
Former Prime Minister of New Zealand / Former UNDP Administrator



Helen Clark became the Administrator of the United Nations Development Program on 17 April 2009, and was the first woman to lead the organization until she stepped down in 2017. She was also Chair of the United Nations Development Group, a committee of the heads of all UN funds, programs and departments working on development issues. Prior to her appointment with UNDP, Helen served for nine years as Prime Minister of New Zealand, serving three successive terms from 1999 - 2008. As Prime Minister, she was a member of the Council of Women World Leaders, a network of current and former women presidents and prime ministers whose mission is to mobilize the highest-level women leaders globally for collective action on issues of critical importance to women and equitable development. First elected to Parliament in 1981, Helen was re-elected to her multicultural Auckland constituency for the tenth time in November 2008.

Walk toward the Kōnan exit of Shinagawa Station.
